FISHERIES MANAGEMENT NOTICE No. 35 of 2007
(Additional November Quota Management Notice)

I, Mary Coughlan, Minister for Agriculture Fisheries and Food (“the Minister”), in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 12 of the Sea-Fisheries and Maritime Jurisdiction Act 2006 (“the Act”), hereby issue the following Notice:

1. This Notice may be cited as Fisheries Management Notice No. 35 of 2007.

2. This Notice comes into force on 21 November 2007.

3. In this Notice:

“CECAF” means the Committee for the Eastern Central Atlantic Fisheries;

“EC waters” means European Community waters. Where this term is used in conjunction with an ICES or CECAF sub-area or division listed in Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 to this Notice, it means that only the European Community waters of that sub-area or division are included for the purposes of this Notice;

“length” means the overall length of a boat, or the distance from the forepart of the stem of the boat to the aft side of the head of the sternpost of the boat or to the foreside of the rudder stock;

“fishing area” means waters falling within the ICES and CECAF sub-areas and divisions listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice as they are defined respectively in Regulation (EEC) No. 3880/91 of 17 December 1991¹, as amended, and Council Regulation (EC) 2597/95 of 23 October 1995², as amended;

“specified period” means the period from 21 November 2007 to 30 November 2007.

4. (a) It is prohibited for an Irish sea-fishing boat greater than or equal to 55 feet in length, or for a person on board that boat, fishing in a fishing area listed in column (2) of Schedule 1 to this Notice, to have or retain on board or land, during the specified period, more of the species of fish given in column (1) of that Schedule opposite that fishing area than the corresponding quantity specified in column (3) of that Schedule if that fish was caught in that fishing area during the specified period.

(b) It is prohibited for an Irish sea-fishing boat less than 55 feet in length, or for a person on board that boat, fishing in a fishing area listed in column (2) of Schedule 1 to this Notice, to have or retain on board or land, during the specified period, more of the species of fish given in column (1) of that Schedule opposite that fishing area than the corresponding quantity specified in column (4) of that Schedule if that fish was caught in that fishing area during the specified period.

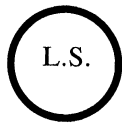

In relation to Compulsory Policies, only policies or part of policies for which the United Kingdom is the state of risk will be transferred and in relation to Irish Motor Policies only policies or part of policies for which Ireland is the state of risk will be transferred.

Copies of the Scheme and of a report (the "Report") in accordance with section 109 of the said Act on the terms of the Scheme by Mr. Ipe Jacob, consulting actuary with Grant Thornton, may be inspected at the office of the Transferors at One Canada Square, London, E14 5AD and of the Transferee at Groupama House (reference RWJ), 24-26 Minories, London EC3N 1DE during usual business hours for at least 21 days beginning with the date of first publication of this notice. Mr. Ipe Jacob, whose appointment was approved by the Financial Services Authority, is the independent expert in respect of the Scheme and the Report considers its impact upon policyholders.

A copy of the Scheme, the Report and a statement setting out the terms of the Scheme and containing a summary of the Report may be obtained by any person free of charge on application in writing to any of the Transferors (reference Robert Barclay) at One Canada Square, London, E14 5AD or to the Transferee (reference RWJ) at Groupama House, 24-26 Minories, London, EC3N 1DE before the making of an order sanctioning the Scheme. Copies of the Scheme, the Report and the statement referred to above may be viewed on the

Groupama and Minster websites at www.groupama.co.uk and www.minsterins.co.uk until the making of such an order.

The application is directed to be heard before the Applications Judge at the Royal Courts of Justice, Strand, London WC2A 2LL on 30 January 2008. Any person (including an employee of any of the Transferors or the Transferee) who alleges that he/she would be adversely affected by the carrying out of the Scheme may appear at the hearing in person or by counsel or solicitor advocate. Any person who intends so to appear, and any policyholder of any of the Transferors or the Transferee who dissents from the Scheme but does not intend so to appear, is requested to give notice in writing of such intention or dissent, and the reasons therefore, to the solicitors named below not less than two normal working days before the hearing.
