**WASTE MANAGEMENT (TYRES AND WASTE TYRES)
 REGULATIONS 2007.**

These Regulations provide for a regulatory framework for comparing quantities of waste tyres arising with quantities placed on the market and for tracking the movement of waste tyres from the time they are discarded until they are either reused or processed for recycling and/or recovery. The Regulations impose obligations on persons who supply tyres to the Irish market, whether as retailers, importers or manufacturers and on persons who manage waste tyres.
