**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (CONDITIONS FOR
 ACCESS TO THE NATURAL GAS TRANSMISSION
 NETWORKS) REGULATIONS 2007.**

On 8 October, 2007, the Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources signed into law the above Regulations, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), as amended by the European Communities (Amendment) Act 1993 (No. 25 of 1993).

These Regulations give full effect to Regulation (EC) No. 1775/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 28 September 2005 on conditions for access to the natural gas transmission networks by providing that the Commission for Energy Regulation shall impose such terms and conditions as it considers necessary on every gas transmission licence, and shall take such other measures as it considers necessary, for the purpose of ensuring that every holder of such a licence complies with the provisions of Regulation 1775/2005.
