### MERCHANT SHIPPING (SAFETY OF FISHING VESSELS) (15-24 METRES) REGULATIONS 2007.

These Regulations apply to every mechanically propelled fishing vessel of 15 metres in length overall and over but less than 24 metres in length, registered in the State.

The regulations set out the standards for the safe construction and equipment of fishing vessels and also the survey and certification requirements for new and existing vessels. The regulations will apply initially to new vessels and then to existing vessels on a phased basis. The licensing authority may not issue a licence until a vessel complies with the safety requirements and the owner submits a copy of a certificate confirming this.

**HEALTH (REPAYMENT SCHEME) (CHARGE FOR ADMINISTERING PATIENTS' PRIVATE PROPERTY ACCOUNTS) REGULATIONS 2007.**

*(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).*

These Regulations are made under section 20 of the Health (Repayment Scheme) Act 2006 and provide for the Health Service Executive (HSE) to impose a charge for administering Patient Private Property Accounts (PPPAs). PPPAs are operated by the HSE to support patients in managing their financial affairs and assisting them in dealing with various aspects of daily living.

The regulations allow 25% of interest earned on these accounts be retained to offset the costs of administering these accounts. These administration costs relate to the costs associated with the central investment unit established to invest funds and costs associated with the external audit of these accounts. The charge will not apply to locally held accounts, the costs of which will be met by the HSE.
