FISHERIES ACTS 1959 TO 2006

SOUTH WESTERN FISHERIES REGION NO. 7 OR KERRY DISTRICT CONSERVATION OF SALMON AND SEA TROUT BYE-LAW NO. 844 2008.

I, Eamon Ryan, Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959) section 33 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 and the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the South Western Fisheries Region (No. 7 or Kerry District) Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye Law No. 844 2008.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 6 August 2008.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Bye-law, it is prohibited for any person to take or to fish for, or attempt to take or to fish for, salmon or sea trout with a draft net or rod and line from the waters described in Article 3.

The waters referred to in Article 2 are—

- (a) that part seaward of the defined mouth of the River Laune defined as a straight line drawn in a southerly direction from Pointantirrig, in the townland of Callanafersy West, to a point in the townland of Reen, and
- (b) that part seaward of the defined mouth of the River Caragh defined as a straight line drawn in a Northerly direction from Reenanallagane Point, in the townland of Reenanallagane, to Black Point in the townland of Dooaghs, and
- (c) that part seaward of the defined mouth of the River Behy defined as a straight line drawn in a due westerly direction from a point in the townland of Kilnabrack Lower to the point in the townland of Rosbehy, and
- (d) that part seaward of the defined mouth of the River Maine defined as a straight line drawn in a northeasterly direction from Rosecullen Point, in the townland of Callanafersy West, to Laghtacallow Point in the townland of Laghtacallow,

all in the county of Kerry, as defined by the Definition No. D. 25 made on 3 March, 1865, by the Special Commissioners appointed under the Salmon Fishery (Ireland) Act 1863.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation)

This Bye-law prohibits fishing for salmon and sea trout by means of a draft net and rod and line in the waters specified in the Bye-law.

FOOTNOTE

Section 11 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 provides that any person aggrieved by this Bye-law may within 28 days after its publication in the *Iris Oifigiúil*, appeal against same to the High Court.
