POISON REGULATIONS 2008.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal instrument).

These Regulations consolidate and replace the Poisons Regulations 1982 (S.I. No. 188 of 1982) (as amended). Unlike the 1982 Regulations, they do not have effect in respect of animal remedies, medicinal products (for human use) and cosmetic products, as each of these product categories are now controlled as such products in their own right.

These Regulations provide that the retail sale of certain poisons (i.e. those specified in Part 1 of Schedule 1) may only take place at retail pharmacies by or under the supervision of registered pharmacists. The Regulations also provide that certain other poisons (i.e. those specified in Part 2 of Schedule 1) may be sold by retail outlets licensed for that purpose, as well as through pharmacies. These latter poisons are intended mainly for use by persons engaged in the business of agriculture, horticulture and forestry.

While the general requirement in respect of labelling has been omitted on the basis that such has already been provided for in separate Regulations, the requirements in relation to the labelling of certain poisons such as compressed hydrogen cyanide and salts of paraquat in liquid form are being continued. The Regulations also continue the prohibition on the sale or supply of strychnine except in very limited circumstances. Specific requirements in regard to record keeping in respect of certain poisons (i.e. those in Schedule 2) are also laid down.

MEDICINAL PRODUCTS (PRESCRIPTION AND
CONTROL OF SUPPLY) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2008.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal instrument).

The purpose of these Regulations are—

- (a) to bring certain of the terminology used in the Medicinal Products (Prescription and Control of Supply) Regulations 2003 (as amended) into line with that in the Pharmacy Act 2007 (No. 20 of 2007);
- (b) to facilitate the control of medicinal products as such products in their own right and not as scheduled poisons as has been the case to date. The passing of the Pharmacy Act 2007, including the amendments made by Section 74 of that Act to the Poisons Act 1961 (No. 12 of 1961), has enabled the exclusion from the scope of the Poisons Act, of all of those substances the sole use of which is as a medicinal product;
- (c) to make certain amendments to the Medicinal Products (Prescription and Control of Supply) Regulations 2003 (as amended) in order to make the provisions of those Regulations clearer as between the controls that have their origin in these Regulations and those that follow the assignment of the various sub-category classifications by the Irish Medicines Board in its granting of marketing authorisations;
- (d) to make certain changes to the controls applicable to certain liquid preparations containing paracetamol with a view to making the controls clearer; and
- (e) to update the list of medicinal products that may be supplied to the various grades of ambulance personnel (i.e. advanced paramedics, paramedics and emergency medical technicians) for use in the course of their work in pre-hospital emergency care.
