**WASTE MANAGEMENT (CERTIFICATION OF
HISTORIC UNLICENCED WASTE DISPOSAL AND
RECOVERY ACTIVITY) REGULATIONS 2008.**

These Regulations provide for the certification of historic unlicensed waste disposal sites in operation between 1977 and 1996, when our modern waste legislation came into effect. The Regulations will provide for the registration of these facilities by the local authorities, the carrying out of a screening risk assessment of the sites and the determination of any remedial measures required (all of which will be the responsibility of the relevant local authority). These facilities will require a certificate of authorisation from the EPA. This certificate will determine the adequacy of the risk assessment and may specify further necessary measures to ensure the protection of the environment.

The Regulations also make a number of minor amendments to waste legislation.

The Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, Mr. Eamon Ryan, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 46A of the Communications Regulation Act 2002 (No. 20 of 2002) (as inserted by Section 14 of the Communications Regulation (Amendment) Act 2007 (No. 22 of 2007)) and for the purpose of amending Regulations made under Section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) giving effect to Directive 2002/58/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 July 2002, has made the Regulations entitled as above.

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Data Protection and Privacy) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 535 of 2003) by:

- (1) increasing the penalty for a summary offence,
- (2) creating an indictable offence for a contravention of Regulation 13 relating to unsolicited communications and providing for the penalties that may be imposed on conviction of same,
- (3) the amendment of Regulations or part thereof relating to confidentiality of communications, unsolicited communications and enforcement respectively in the interest of clarity.

These Regulations came into effect on the day after the date on which notice of their making is published in the *Iris Oifigiúil*.

POLICY GUIDANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 60 OF THE WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT 1996 (AS AMENDED) REGARDING ACTION AGAINST ILLEGAL WASTE ACTIVITY — THE USE OF SANCTIONS.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 60 of the Waste Management Act 1996 (as amended), Mr. John Gormley, T.D., Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government issued on 25 July, 2008, the above policy direction.

The purpose of the direction is to further strengthen the Irish enforcement system in order to meet the requirements of the Waste Framework Directive. The direction requires the Environmental Protection Agency and local authorities to prepare an Enforcement Policy on Unauthorised Waste Activities. This direction should be read in conjunction with the previous policy direction issued on 3 May, 2005.
