EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (ADDITIVES, COLOURS AND SWEETENERS IN FOODSTUFFS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008.

These Regulations give effect to Directive 2006/52/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 July, 2006, insofar as it amends Directive 94/35/EC on sweeteners for use in foodstuffs. These Regulations amend the European Communities (Additives, Colours and Sweeteners in Foodstuffs) Regulations 2000 (S.I. No. 437 of 2000).

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Additives, Colours and Sweeteners in Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

FOYLE AREA AND CARLINGFORD AREA
(LICENSING OF FISHING ENGINES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2007

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area and Carlingford Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 2001 by amending the dates by which applications for commercial salmon licences must reach the Commission.

FOYLE AREA AND CARLINGFORD AREA
(LICENSING OF FISHING ENGINES) (AMENDMENT
No. 2) REGULATIONS 2007

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area and Carlingford Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 2001 by retaining the Schedule to those Regulations with the omission of the references to Drift Nets used wholly to Seaward of Lough Foyle and Drift Nets used partly in Lough Foyle and partly seaward of the seaward limit of Lough Foyle.

FOYLE AREA AND CARLINGFORD AREA (TAGGING
AND LOGBOOK) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area and Carlingford Area (Tagging and Logbook) Regulations 2001 regarding angling logbooks and gill tags.

FOYLE AREA AND CARLINGFORD AREA (ANGLING)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007.

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area and Carlingford Area (Angling) Regulations 2001 regarding restrictions on numbers and sizes of fish taken by rod and line.

FOYLE AREA (CONTROL OF NETTING)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area (Control of Netting) Regulations 1981 by prescribing the maximum length of a drift net which can operate in Lough Foyle at and providing that drift nets may not be operated in the Foyle Area seawards of Lough Foyle.

FOYLE AREA (CONTROL OF DRIFT AND DRAFT NET
FISHING) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area (Control of Drift and Draft Net Fishing) Regulations 2004, and prescribe the maximum number of licences which the Foyle, Carlingford and Irish Lights Commission may issue for drift and draft net fishing in the tidal waters of the Foyle Area.

FOYLE AREA AND CARLINGFORD AREA (ANGLING)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area and Carlingford Area (Angling) Regulations 2001 by prohibiting angling on a stretch of the River Finn upstream of Cloghan Bridge, County Donegal.
