No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following Bye-law:

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the Eastern Fisheries Region (River Slaney) (Angling) Bye-law No. C.S. 296, 2008.
2. This Bye-law comes into operation on 26 February 2008.
3. Angling for salmon or trout with rod and line is prohibited in the River Slaney and its tributaries during the period commencing 26 February 2008 and ending 9 March 2008.
4. In this Bye-law "salmon" and "trout" shall have the meanings assigned to them by section 3 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), as amended.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Bye-law provides that the annual close season for salmon and trout in the River Slaney and its tributaries shall be extended from 26 February, 2008 to 9 March, 2008, both dates inclusive.

FOOTNOTE

Section 11 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 provides that any person aggrieved by this Bye-law may within 28 days after its publication in the *Iris Oifigiúil*, appeal against same to the High Court.

CONSERVATION OF SALMON AND SEA TROUT

BYE-LAW No. 833, 2008

I, EAMON RYAN, Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following Bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. 833, 2008.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 1 March 2008.

2. In this Bye-law—

“salmon” means fish of the species *Salmo salar* (Atlantic salmon);

“sea trout” means fish of the migratory form of *Salmo trutta*, but does not include a sea trout which is 40 centimetres or less in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. C.S. 293, 2007, it is prohibited for a person to—

(a) take, or attempt to take, by rod and line any salmon or sea trout from the waters of the Lower Shannon from O’Briens Bridge downstream on the downstream face of the bridge, to Thomond Bridge in the city of Limerick, unless the fish is handled carefully and immediately returned alive to those waters, or

(b) use or attempt to use any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, or worms as bait in angling for salmon or sea trout in those waters.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Bye-law provides for catch and release in respect of salmon and sea trout (over 40cm) in the portion of the Lower Shannon from O’Briens Bridge downstream on the downstream face of the bridge, to Thomond Bridge. The Bye-law also prohibits the use of worms as bait and any fish hooks other than single barbless hooks in angling for salmon and trout in those waters.

FOOTNOTE

Section 11 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959 provides that any person aggrieved by this Bye-law may within 28 days after its publication in the *Iris Oifigiúil*, appeal against same to the High Court.
