SEA-FISHERIES (FISHING FOR COD) REGULATIONS 2008.

These Regulations transpose into Irish law the provisions of Annex IIa of Council Regulation (EC) No. 40/2008, which establishes, for fishing vessels greater than 10 metres in overall length and operating in certain waters, a fishing effort limitation scheme in the context of the recovery of certain fish stocks, and the provisions of Council Regulation (EC) No. 423/2004 (Cod Recovery Plan) which establishes measures for the recovery of cod stocks and additional conditions for monitoring, inspection and surveillance.

DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1966 (BLUETONGUE) (RESTRICTION ON IMPORTS FROM RESTRICTED ZONES) ORDER 2008.

This will apply to cattle or sheep for breeding/fattening (but not those for slaughter).
