INFECTIOUS DISEASES (MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 2008.

CONSERVATION OF SALMON AND SEA TROUT  
BYE-LAW No. 829, 2007

I, Eamon Ryan, Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 for the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. 829, 2007.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 1 January 2008.

2. In this Bye-law—

“salmon” means fish of the species *Salmo salar* (Atlantic salmon);

“sea trout” means fish of the migratory form of *Salmo trutta*, but does not include a sea trout which is 40 centimetres or less in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any bye-law prohibiting the taking or having in possession of more than a specified number of salmon or sea trout, a person shall not take by rod and line more than 10 fish (being either salmon or sea trout or a combination of both) in any year.

4. Subject to Article 5, a person shall not take by rod and line—

(a) during the year 2008 from 1 January to 11 May, more than 3 fish, but not more than one fish on any day during that period, or

(b) on any day in any year—

(i) from 12 May to 31 August, more than 3 fish, or

(ii) from 1 September to the end of the season, more than one fish,

being either salmon or sea trout.

5. It is prohibited for a person, in a river mentioned in column (2) opposite mention of a fishery district in column (1), of the Schedule, where he or she has taken the number of fish permitted under Article 3 or 4 to—

(a) take by rod and line any salmon or sea trout from the waters of the river, unless the fish is handled carefully, not removed from and immediately returned alive, to those waters, or

(b) use or attempt to use any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, or worms as bait in angling for salmon or sea trout in the waters of the river.

6. The Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. 820, 2007 is revoked.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

*(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation.)*

This Bye-Law provides for an annual bag limit of 10 fish being either salmon or sea trout (over 40 cm) per angler for the 2008 season and provides for a season bag limit of 3 fish in the period 1 Jan to 11 May, a daily bag limit of 3 fish from 12 May to 31 August and a daily bag limit of 1 fish from 1 September to the end of the season. The Bye-law also provides for the use of single hooks and prohibits the use of worms as bait once the specified number of fish have been caught in the specified periods.

### FOOTNOTE

Section 11 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959 provides that any person aggrieved by this Bye-law may within 28 days after its publication in the *Irish Oifigiúil*, appeal against same to the High Court.
