CASUAL TRADING BYE-LAWS (DROICHEAD NUA) 2007

By virtue of the power conferred on the Council by Section 6 of the Casual Trading Act 1995, the Council gives notice of the adoption of bye-laws to designate a casual trading area at George's Street, Droichead Nua [exclusive of any part of Main Street, Eyre Street and the area known as Market Square), for a Farmer's Market, to take place each Saturday from 9.00am to 2.00pm.
