EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (MANUFACTURE,
PRESENTATION AND SALE OF TOBACCO
PRODUCTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal instrument.)

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Manufacture, Presentation and Sale of Tobacco Products) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 425 of 2003).

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Manufacture, Presentation and Sale of Tobacco Products) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

These Regulations give further effect to Directive 2001/37/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 June 2001 on the approximation of the laws, regulations and administrative provisions of the Member States concerning the manufacture, presentation and sale of tobacco products. In particular, these Regulations require the warning notices and information notices concerning nicotine, tar and carbon monoxide on tobacco products to appear in both the Irish and English languages.
