WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1926 (SECTION 3)  
(EXEMPTION OF APPARATUS FOR MOBILE  
COMMUNICATION SERVICES ON AIRCRAFT) ORDER  
2008.

The Commission for Communications Regulation has made a Statutory Instrument, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3(6) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1926 (No. 45 of 1926) (inserted by section 11(c) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act, 1972 (No. 5 of 1972)), transferred to it by section 9(1) of the Communications Regulation Act 2002 (No. 20 of 2002).

This Order provides for the exemption of certain wireless telegraphy apparatus, associated with the provision of mobile communication services on board aircraft, from the requirement to be licenced under the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1926.

EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (QUALITY AND SAFETY  
OF HUMAN BLOOD AND BLOOD COMPONENTS)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008.

These Regulations are made under section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) (as amended by the European Communities (Amendment) Act 2007 (No. 18 of 2007)).

The Regulations amend Article 2(1) of the European Communities (Quality and Safety of Human Blood and Blood Components) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 360 of 2005) by the insertion of part (c) under the definition of “qualified health professional”. This amendment allows for a “a person, who has successfully completed a training course approved by a blood establishment, which established the competency of that person to assess the eligibility of donors to donate” to be included under the definition of “qualified health professional”.

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Quality and Safety of Human Blood and Blood Components) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.
