The Minister for Transport, Mr. Noel Dempsey T.D., has made the above named Order.

This Order completes transposition of Directive 2004/49/EC on Safety on the Community's Railways (The Railway Safety Directive), the principal elements of which were transposed under the Railway Safety Act 2005. The regulations provide for, inter alia, new reporting requirements on the safety authority in Ireland (The Railway Safety Commission) to the European Commission / European Railway Agency; certain amendments to the Railway Safety Act 2005 in relation to safety approval procedures for railway undertakings in Ireland; and additional functions of the Railway Incident Investigation Unit and provisions in relation to reporting and investigation of railway accidents and incidents.

HEALTH ACT 2007 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDER 2008

This Statutory Instrument brings into operation section 8(1)(c) and associated provisions of the Health Act 2007 (No. 23 of 2007) with effect from the 29 day of February 2008.

Section 8(1)(c) of the Act provides for the Health Information and Quality Authority to monitor compliance with standards it sets on safety and quality of services. The associated provisions provide for the appointment by the Authority of authorised persons to monitor compliance with standards set by the Authority in accordance with section 8(1)(c) and for such authorised persons to have powers set out in Part 9 of the Act respecting the monitoring of compliance with standards set. The provisions also relate to offences and proceedings under Part 10 of the Act in this regard.
