NOTICE TO MANUFACTURERS, IMPORTERS,  
DISTRIBUTORS AND RETAILERS OF MAGNETIC  
TOYS

Concerning the European Commission Decision relating to Magnetic Toys.

The European Commission Decision 2008/329/EC of 21 April 2008 requires Member States to ensure that magnetic toys placed or made available on the market display a warning concerning potential health and safety risks. All toys containing magnets must carry a warning with the following wording:

- “Warning! This toy contains magnets or magnetic components. Magnets sticking together or becoming attached to a metallic object inside the human body can cause serious or fatal injury. Seek immediate medical help if magnets are swallowed or inhaled,” or
- an equivalent easily understandable wording that clearly conveys the same content.
- The warning must be clearly visible and legible, conspicuously displayed at the point of purchase, on the packaging or otherwise attached to the magnetic toy.

Member States are required to ensure that as of 21 July 2008:

- magnetic toys which do not display the required warning, are prohibited from being placed or made available on the market,
- magnetic toys placed or made available on the market which do not display the required warning are withdrawn from the market, and
- consumers are adequately informed of the risk.

The Commission Decision, made under Article 13 of General Product Safety Directive 2001/95/EC was published in the Official Journal on 26 April 2008-L114/90.

The National Consumer Agency has responsibility for implementing the Commission Decision in Ireland. The Customs Authorities are cooperating with the National Consumer Agency in implementing the Decision. The National Consumer Agency is empowered to issue a direction to any operator found not to be complying with the Commission Decision. Any person who fails to comply with such a direction may be guilty of an offence and liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding €3,000 and/or imprisonment for 3 months.

NOTICE TO MANUFACTURERS, IMPORTERS,  
DISTRIBUTORS AND RETAILERS OF CIGARETTE  
LIGHTERS

Concerning the European Commission Decision relating to the Prohibition on the Placing of Certain Cigarette Lighters on the Market.

The European Commission Decision 2008/322/EC of 18 April 2008 prolongs the validity of Decision 2006/502/EC, concerning the prohibition and sale of certain lighters, until 11 May 2009. Decision 2008/322/EC was published in the Official Journal of the European Union on 19 April 2008 — L 109/40.

Decision 2006/502/EC, amended by Decision 2008/322/EC, requires Member States to take measures to:

- ensure that as of 11 May 2008 all non-refillable lighters placed on the market are child-resistant,
- prohibit the placing on the market of novelty and child appealing lighters.

Decision 2006/502/EC and Decision 2008/322/EC are adopted in accordance with the provisions of Article 13 of the General Product Safety Directive 2001/95/EC.

The National Consumer Agency, with the cooperation of the Customs Authorities, has responsibility for implementing the Commission Decision in Ireland. The National Consumer Agency is empowered to issue a direction to any operator found not to be complying with the Commission Decision. Any person who fails to comply with such a direction may be guilty of an offence and liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding €3,000 and/or imprisonment for 3 months.

By way of information, European Commission Decision 2008/357/EC of 23 April 2008 outlines specific child safety requirements to be met by European standards for lighters pursuant to Directive 2001/95/EC on General Product Safety.
