DETERMINATION (No. 10) OF THE NEED FOR AN
AUTHORISATION FOR CERTAIN FISH STOCKS

I, John Browne, Minister of State at the Department of Agriculture Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 13(15) of the Sea-Fisheries and Maritime Jurisdiction Act 2006 (“the Act”) and the Marine (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) (No. 2) Order 2006, hereby determine:

1. With effect from 06 May 2008, an authorisation, granted under section 13(1) of the Act is required by an Irish sea-fishing boat of a type specified in column (3) of the Schedule to this Determination to fish for, retain on board, trans-ship or land from that boat the fish stock, or group of fish stocks, given in column (2) of that Schedule opposite that type of boat.

2. In this Determination, the ICES areas mentioned in column (2) of the Schedule to this Determination refer to the waters falling within those ICES sub-areas and divisions as they are defined in Regulation (EEC) No. 3880/91 of 17 December 1991¹, as amended.

3. This Determination revokes and replaces the Determination (No. 9) of the Need for an Authorisation for Certain Fish Stocks, which came into effect on 30 January 2008.
