EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (CROSS-BORDER MERGERS) REGULATIONS 2008.

Mary Coughlan T.D., Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), has made Regulations entitled as above. The Regulations give full effect to Directive 2005/56/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 October, 2005, which introduces a system for companies to engage in cross-border restructuring that did not exist previously.

These Regulations, which take immediate effect, provide a framework whereby limited liability Companies may engage in a cross border merger. The methods by which this can occur are defined in Regulation 2 by reference to three categories, i.e. a merger by acquisition, a merger by formation of a new Company and a merger by absorption. The merger must involve at least two Companies, each one of which is formed and registered in a separate EEA State, and is entitled to merge under the national law of that EEA State.

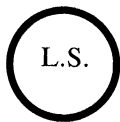
