**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (LABELLING,  
 PRESENTATION AND ADVERTISING OF  
 FOODSTUFFS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008.**

*(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal instrument.)*

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) Regulations 2002 (S.I. No. 451 of 2003), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 528 of 2003), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 228 of 2005), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 514 of 2005), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 647 of 2005), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 376 of 2007), and the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 808 of 2007).

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

These Regulations implement Commission Directive 2007/68/EC of 27 November, 2007, amending Annex IIIa to Directive 2000/13/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards certain food ingredients.

**SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE AT WORK  
(CONSTRUCTION) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2)  
REGULATIONS 2008.**

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 504 of 2006), as previously amended by the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) (Amendment) Regulations 2008 (S.I. No. 130 of 2008), by substituting revised provisions for Regulation 97, relating to guarding, lighting and signage in connection with construction works on roads, footpaths and cycle tracks.

The revised provisions come into operation from 6 July, 2009.
