EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (RESTRICTIVE MEASURES) (IRAN) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008.

The Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, Mary Coughlan, T.D., in exercise of the powers conferred on her by Section 3 (as amended by Section 2 of the European Communities Act 2007 (No. 18 of 2007)) of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), has made an Order that may be cited as the European Communities (Restrictive Measures) (Iran) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

The effect of this Order is to amend the Statutory Instrument that provided penalties for infringements of Council Regulation (EC) No. 423/2007 of 19 April, 2007. The Council Regulation introduced restrictions on the export of goods and technology which could contribute to Iran's enrichment-related, reprocessing, or heavy water-related activities, or to the development of nuclear weapon delivery systems. It also bans the provision of technical assistance, brokering services and investments related to, and the procurement of, such goods and technology from Iran. The amendments, which give effect to Commission Regulation (EC) No. 116/2008, replace Annexes I and III of the Council Regulation. The effect of this Order is to commence from 20 November, 2008.
