EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (DIRECTIVE 2006/100/EC)
(RECOGNITION OF BULGARIAN AND ROMANIAN
MEDICAL QUALIFICATIONS) REGULATIONS 2008.

These Regulations amend the definition of Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council which is provided for in Section 2 of the Medical Practitioners Act 2007, to include the amendment of that Directive by Council Directive 2008/100/EC.

The effect of this amendment is to allow for the recognition of medical qualifications of Romanian and Bulgarian medical practitioners by the Medical Council under the provisions of the 2007 Act.
