EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (MACHINERY) REGULATIONS 2008.

The Regulations come into effect on 29 December, 2009 and implement Article 24 of Directive 2006/42/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 May, 2006, on machinery and amending Directive 95/16/EC of 29 June, 1995. In the case of portable cartridge operated fixing and other impact machinery that are in conformity with existing provisions in force at 17 May, 2006, the Regulations come into effect on 29 June, 2011.

Article 24 of this Directive is implemented separately through the European Communities (Lifts) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

These Regulations provide for the continued harmonisation of the essential health and safety requirements on machinery across the European Union while also promoting the free movement of machinery within the single market.
