EDUCATION AND SCIENCE (DELEGATION OF MINISTERIAL FUNCTIONS) ORDER 2007.

For the avoidance of doubt, this notice is to confirm that, in exercise of the power conferred by them by section 1 of the Ministers and Secretaries (Amendment) (No. 2) Act 1977 (No. 28 of 1977) the Government, on the nomination of An Taoiseach, had appointed Mr. Seán Haughey T.D., to be Minister of State at the Department of Education and Science. A notice of this appointment was published in Iris Oifigiúil on 15th December 2006.

SHANNON FISHERIES REGION No. 8 OR LIMERICK
DISTRICT (RIVER SMEARLAGH AND RIVER
GLASHOREAG) BYE-LAW No. C.S. 300, 2008.

I, EAMON RYAN, Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following Bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Shannon Fisheries Region No. 8 or Limerick District (River Smearlagh and River Glashoreag) Bye-Law No. C.S. 300, 2008.
- (2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 4 September 2008.
2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any bye-law fixing the annual close season, angling for any kind of fish is prohibited in the waters of the River Smearlagh and River Glashoreag in the No. 8 or Limerick District during the period from 4 September 2008 to the end of the season.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Bye-law provides for the prohibition on angling for any kind of fish in the Rivers Smearlagh and Glashoreag commencing on 4 September, 2008, to the end of the season (30 September, 2008).

FOOTNOTE

Section 11 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 provides that any person aggrieved by this Bye-law may within 28 days after its publication in the Iris Oifigiúil, appeal against the same to the High Court.
