## FISHERIES ACTS, 1959-2006

EASTERN FISHERIES REGION No. 2 or  
WEXFORD DISTRICT (RIVER SLANEY)  
BYE-LAW No. 854, 2009

I, SEAN POWER, Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 (as amended by section 6(2) of the Fisheries Act 1980 (No. 1 of 1980)) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and the Energy and Natural Resources (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2008 (S.I. No. 460 of 2008) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Eastern Fisheries Region No. 2 or Wexford District (River Slaney) Bye-law No. 854, 2009.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on the day after the day of its making.

2. In this Bye-law—

“day”, for the purpose of Article 3 in relation to angling for sea trout, includes, where a person is angling for sea trout on any particular day and the angling continues beyond midnight into the following day, any such angling up to 8 o'clock on the morning of the following day;

“sea trout” means the migratory form of *Salmo trutta* which is 40cm or less in length, measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail;

“specified waters” means the waters of the River Slaney and its tributaries in the No. 2 or Wexford District.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Bye-law prohibiting the taking or having in possession of more than a specified number of sea trout, a person shall not take from, or have in his or her possession in or on the banks of the specified waters more than 2 sea trout in any day from the commencement of this Bye-law up to the end of the season.

4. It is permitted for a person in the specified waters, where he or she has taken the number of sea trout permitted under Article 3, to take by rod and line any further sea trout from the specified waters, where the fish is handled carefully, not removed from and immediately returned alive to those waters.

5. A person angling for sea trout in accordance with this Bye-law shall not use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE.

*(This note is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).*

This Bye-law prohibits the taking of more than two sea trout under 40 cm in the waters of the River Slaney or its tributaries in any one day, as specified in the Bye-law, up to the end of the season. The Bye-law also prohibits the use of worms as bait and any fish hooks other than single barbless hooks in angling for sea trout under 40 cm.

## FOOTNOTE

Section 11 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959 provides that any person aggrieved by this Bye-law may within 28 days after its publication in the *Iris Oifigiúil*, appeal against same to the High Court.

BYE-LAW No. 855, 2009

I, SEAN POWER, Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 (as amended by section 6(2) of the Fisheries Act 1980 (No. 1 of 1980)) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and the Energy and Natural Resources (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2008 (S.I. No. 460 of 2008) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Eastern Fisheries Region Avoca River System (Catch and Release) Bye-law No. 855, 2009.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on the day after the day of its making and ceases to have effect on 31 December 2011.

2. In this Bye-law—

“Avoca River System” includes all the waters that drain the area upstream of the mouth of the Avoca as defined in Definition No. D. 120 No. 2 or Wexford District which was made by the then Minister for Lands and Fisheries on 10 April 1931;

“sea trout” means the migratory form of *Salmo trutta* which is 40cm or less in length, measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Bye-law, it is prohibited for any person to take by means of rod and line any sea trout from the waters of the Avoca River System unless such sea trout is handled carefully and immediately returned alive to the waters from which it is taken.

4. A person angling for sea trout in accordance with Article 3 shall not use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Bye-law prohibits the taking of any sea trout under 40cm by means of rod and line from the Avoca System (as defined in Definition No. D. 120 No. 2 or Wexford District, Volume XXIII of the Statutory Rules, Orders and Regulations 1922-1938 (Fisheries)) unless such sea trout is handled carefully and immediately returned alive to the waters from which it is taken. The Bye-law also prohibits the use of worms as bait and any fish hooks other than single barbless hooks in angling for sea trout under 40 cm.
