This notice is issued pursuant to Regulation 15 of the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Access) Regulations 2003 S.I. No. 305 of 2003 as amended by the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Access) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 S.I. No. 373 of 2007 (together the 'Access Regulations') and pursuant to Regulation 30 of the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Universal Service and Users' Rights) Regulations 2003 S.I. No. 308 of 2003 as amended by the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Universal Service and Users' Rights) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 S.I. No. 374 of 2007 (together the 'Universal Service Regulations').

TAKE NOTICE that the Commission for Communications Regulation ('ComReg'), in exercise of its powers under the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Framework) Regulations 2003 S.I. No. 307 of 2003 as amended by the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Framework) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 S.I. No. 271 of 2007 (together the 'Framework Regulations'), has designated Eircom Limited with significant market power on the following market in Ireland:

- Wholesale terminating segments of leased lines, irrespective of the technology used to provide leased or dedicated capacity.

Pursuant to the Access Regulations, ComReg has imposed regulatory obligations on that undertaking in that market.

And

TAKE NOTICE that ComReg in exercise of its powers under the Framework Regulations has removed the designation of significant market power on Eircom Limited in respect of the following markets in Ireland:

- Wholesale trunk segments of leased lines
- Retail market for the minimum set of leased lines

ComReg has removed the regulatory obligations previously imposed pursuant to the Access Regulations and pursuant to the Universal Service Regulations on that undertaking in those markets.
