They will assist in easing, on an exceptional and temporary basis, some of the eligibility criteria for donors with regard to certain technical requirements for blood and blood components in order to increase the blood supply.

**WASTE MANAGEMENT (FOOD WASTE)
REGULATIONS 2009.**

These Regulations are designed to promote the segregation and recovery of food waste arising in the commercial sector. They will facilitate in particular the achievement of the targets set out in Directive 99/31/EC on the landfill of waste for the diversion of biodegradable municipal waste from landfill sites to composting and to other forms of authorised treatment. They will also increase the amount of food waste that is recovered.

The Regulations impose obligations on the major sources of food waste, such as State buildings where food is prepared, restaurants and cafés, hot food outlets, canteens, hotels and larger guest houses, supermarkets and other food retailers, to segregate these materials and make them available for separate collection. Alternatively, these materials can be treated on the premises where they arise under specified conditions. The Regulations come into operation on 1 January, 2010, but the main provisions only apply from 1 July, 2010.
