COMMISSION TO INQUIRE INTO CHILD ABUSE ACT  
2000 (SECTION 5) (SPECIFIED PERIOD) ORDER 2009.

On 22nd January, 2009, a draft order was laid before Dáil Éireann and Seanad Éireann concerning the Commission to Inquire into Child Abuse Act 2000 to extend the time period within which the Commission could prepare and publish its report, in accordance with its statutory mandate. Under the terms of Section 5(5) of the Commission to Inquire into Child Abuse Act 2000 an order to extend the term of the commission must be approved by both Houses of the Oireachtas.

Consequently, on the 27th and 28th January, 2009, Dáil Éireann and Seanad Éireann each passed motions in approval of the draft order. On 30th January, 2009, An Taoiseach, Mr. Brian Cowen T.D., signed an order in respect of the above in exercise of the powers conferred on the Government by Section 5(5)(b) of the Commission to Inquire into Child Abuse Act 2000.

HEALTH ACT 2007 (SECTION 103) (COMMENCEMENT)  
ORDER 2009.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).*

Section 103 of the Health Act 2007 inserts Part 9A in the Health Act 2004. This Order appoints 1 March 2009 as the date on which Section 103 of the Health Act 2007 comes into operation (except in so far as it relates to Sections 55C and 55G(b) of the Health Act 2004 (inserted by section 103(1)) and except in so far as it relates to “Chief Inspector” in Schedule 2A of the Health Act 2004 (inserted by section 103(2)(b)).

Section 103 provides for the making of protected disclosures by health service employees. A disclosure made by a health service employee in good faith and on reasonable grounds and in accordance with the provisions of Section 103 is a protected disclosure. Similarly, disclosures made by persons to a professional regulatory body and in certain circumstances to the Health Information and Quality Authority or the Inspector of Mental Health Services are also protected under the Act. A person is not liable in damages as a consequence of a protected disclosure and an employer shall not penalise an employee for making a protected disclosure.

SEA-FISHERIES (CONTROL OF CATCHES)  
REGULATIONS 2009.

The effect of these Regulations is to provide for the provisions of Council Regulation (EC) No. 43/2009 of 16 January fixing for 2009 the fishing opportunities and associated conditions for certain fish stocks and groups of fish stocks applicable in Community waters and, for the Community vessels, in waters where catch limitations are required. These Regulations also provide for the provisions of Council Regulation (EC) No. 1342/2008 of 18 December, 2008 which, together with Annex IIa of Council Regulation (EC) No. 43/2009, establishes, for fishing vessels greater than 10 metres in overall length and operating in certain waters, a fishing effort limitation scheme in the context of the recovery of certain fish stocks.
