These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Tobacco) (Registration) Regulations 2009.

Section 37 (inserted by Section 8 of the Public Health (Tobacco) (Amendment) Act 2004 (No. 6 of 2004)) of the Public Health (Tobacco) Act 2002 (No. 6 of 2002) requires all persons who carry on, in whole or in part, the business of selling tobacco products by retail to register with the Office of Tobacco Control. These Regulations allow the Office of Tobacco Control to collect the information necessary for the establishment and maintenance of the register.
