EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Tobacco) (Retail Sign) Regulations 2009.

With effect from 1 July, 2009 Section 43(4)(c) (inserted by Section 14 of the Public Health (Tobacco) (Amendment) Act 2004 (No. 6 of 2004)) of the Public Health (Tobacco) Act 2002 (No. 6 of 2002) requires that a sign as prescribed in these Regulations be displayed at a premises where tobacco products are sold by retail.
