## AUTHORITY

S.I. No. 112 OF 1996.

REGULATION 5(1); REGULATION 6(2)(g) AND  
REGULATION 13 OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES  
(TRADE IN BOVINE BREEDING ANIMALS, THEIR  
SEMEN, OVA AND EMBRYOS) REGULATIONS 1996.

**The Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Food** (hereinafter referred to as “the Minister”) in pursuance of powers vested in him by Regulation 5(1) of the above Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “S.I. 112 of 1996”) **HEREBY**, subject to the conditions and limitations set out in the Schedule hereto, designates, authorises and approves the **Irish Cattle Breeding Federation Society Limited** (hereinafter referred to as “the ICBF”) to be, along with the Minister, a competent authority to grant approvals in relation to any or all of the matters referred to in Regulation 6(2)(g) of S.I. 112 of 1996 relating to semen only for breeding purposes in accordance with Regulation 13.

## SCHEDULE

1. This designation, authority and approval shall commence on the 21st January, 2009;
2. This designation, authority and approval shall continue until 31st December, 2009, unless terminated sooner under the terms of this Schedule;
3. This designation, authority and approval may be terminated by either the Minister or the ICBF giving the other 28 days’ notice in writing, to commence on the date that the notice shall be given by hand to an officer of the ICBF or to an officer of the Minister as appropriate;
4. This designation, authority and approval may be terminated by the Minister at any time if he/she is of the opinion that the terms of this authority are not being complied with or the terms of S.I. 112 of 1996 are being breached by the ICBF;
5. This designation, authority and approval is for the ICBF to be a competent authority for the purposes outlined above alongside the Minister and the authority is without prejudice to the Minister’s continued authority in that regard;
6. The relationship between the Minister and the European Commission is in no way affected by this authority and he will continue to be the sole contact point with the European Commission;
7. The Minister reserves the right to alter the terms of these conditions and limitations should this prove necessary in the light of fresh Communities Legislation in this area;
8. The Minister reserves the right to audit a percentage of approvals made by ICBF under this authority being a minimum of 5% (or more at the Minister’s discretion) of the total of any completed 6 month period, the first such audit to be made on or after 1st July, 2009 at the discretion of the Minister and thereafter annually on or after the anniversary of 1st July, 2010 in relation to 5%

(or more at the Minister’s discretion) of the previous completed 12 month period;

9. Grants of Approval issuing from the ICBF will not be limited under Regulation 6(2)(g) of S.I. 112 of 1996 to applications from members of the ICBF but shall be open to members and non-members alike;
10. Breaches by applicants in relation to the terms and conditions of approvals shall immediately be notified by the ICBF to the Minister so as to enable the Minister to investigate and prosecute, where appropriate, any offences in relation to Regulation 26 of S.I. 112 of 1996;
11. ICBF will provide the Minister with the following information upon request and in a format that is acceptable to the Minister. The information shall contain the following details for each approved bull: Bull AI Code, Name of Bull, Country of Registration, Herd Book Number/National ID Number, Genetic Defects, Name of Applicant, Breed, Approval Status (Unrestricted Use, Official Test Purposes, Special Breeding Purposes), Conditions of approval where applicable and number of progeny registered.
12. Any changes to the fees charged for the approval of semen in AI must be approved by the Minister.
