**ENERGY (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 2006  
 (SECTION 13) (COMMENCEMENT OF REMAINING  
 PROVISIONS) ORDER 2009.**

On 29th June, 2009, the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources signed into law the above named Order, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(2) of the Energy (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006 (No. 40 of 2006) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)).

This Order brings into operation on 29 June 2009, subsections (3) and (4) of section 13 of the Energy (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006. With effect from the 29th June 2009 the Commission for Energy Regulation may take a prosecution and the courts may impose penalties against persons not registered as gas installers who carry out designated gas works.
