ROADS ACT (DECLARATION OF MOTORWAYS) ORDER 2009.

The Minister for Transport, Mr. Noel Dempsey T.D., has made the above Statutory Instrument.

This Order gives effect to section 8 of the Roads Act 2007 which provides for the declaration of certain public roads as motorways.

On a motorway, higher maximum speed limits may be set than on other public roads, access to specific types of road user or vehicle may be restricted, and protection can be afforded to the State's investment in the national road network to prevent premature obsolescence. This Order applies only to high quality dual carriageways which were already built, under construction or in planning when the Roads Act 2007 was enacted.

This Order will come into operation on 28th August, 2009.

These Regulations replace the European Communities (Marine Equipment) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 38 of 2003). They give effect to Council Directive 96/98/EC of 20 December, 1996, on Marine Equipment, as amended by Commission Directive 98/85/EC of 11 November, 1998, Commission Directive 2001/53/EC, Commission Directive 2002/75/EC, Article 5 of Commission Directive 2002/84/EC of 5 November, 2002 and Commission Directive 2008/67/EC of 30 June, 2008, which were introduced by the European Community to enhance safety at sea and prevention of marine pollution through the uniform application of the relevant international instruments relating to certain marine equipment.
