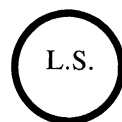

The Code of Practice (CoP) was developed in response to a Policy Direction issued on July 25th, 2008, by the Minister under Section 60 of the Waste Management Act. It provides guidance to local authorities for developing an enforcement policy for unauthorised waste activities. The CoP sets out a framework to allow for systematic and consistent enforcement actions to be taken by local authorities against illegal waste operations.

The Code of Practice comes into effect on 17th July, 2009.

PROPOSED TAXI RANK BYE-LAWS
