CIRCUIT COURT RULES (ACTIONS FOR POSSESSION AND WELL-CHARGING RELIEF) 2009.

The Circuit Court Rules Committee, with the concurrence of the Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform, has made Rules, entitled as above which amend the Circuit Court Rules to introduce a new procedure in respect of the preparation for trial of proceedings for recovery of possession of land on foot of a legal mortgage or charge and proceedings to declare a mortgage well charged on land. Such proceedings will be initiated by a new form of Civil Bill supported by affidavit and defended by a replying affidavit, and will be returnable initially to a hearing before the county registrar, at which the County Registrar may make or give various orders or directions.
