CHARITIES ACT 2009 (COMMENCEMENT)
ORDER 2009.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Order commences Sections 2, 5, 10 and 99, of the Charities Act 2009 (“the Act”). The purpose of this Order is to make it an offence for a Mass Card to be sold in Contravention of the provisions of Section 99 of the Act. Section 99 of the Act requires that Mass Cards may only be sold under an arrangement with a “recognised person”. A recognised person for the purposes of Section 99 means a bishop, or a provincial of an order of priests established under the authority of, and recognised by, the Holy Catholic Apostolic and Roman Church. Section 10 of the Act sets out the possible penalties on conviction for a breach of Section 99. Section 5 is a technical section that provides that expenses incurred by the Minister in the administration of the Act shall be paid out of moneys provided by the Oireachtas. Section 2 of the Act contains the definitions of certain terms used in the Act.

The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government has made the following Regulations:

S.I. No. 286 of 2009.

WASTE MANAGEMENT (PROHIBITION OF WASTE DISPOSAL BY BURNING) REGULATIONS 2009.

These Regulations explicitly prohibit various waste disposal practices by uncontrolled burning of waste such as, for example, backyard burning of waste. The Regulations provide a limited set of exemptions such as for certain agricultural practices but only after specified steps are taken to, inter alia, reduce, and recycle waste arisings. These Regulations came into effect on 27 July 2009.

HEALTH (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 2009 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDER 2009.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Order brings Part 1, Part 2 and Section 65 of the Health (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2009 into operation.

Part 1 provides that the Act will come into operation by Ministerial order and that different provisions of the Act may be brought into operation at different times; gives definitions and provides for expenses.

Part 2 provides for the dissolution of the National Council on Ageing and Older People and for the transfer of the Council's employees, liabilities, property etc, to the Minister for Health and Children.

Section 65 amends Article 5 of the National Cancer Registry Board (Establishment) Order 1991 to provide for the appointment by the Minister of a seven person Board with knowledge or experience of the collection, recording and analysis of information, or the use of such information in research projects and the management and planning of services, or have other relevant competencies to assist the Board in the performance of its functions.
