**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (INFANT FORMULAE
 AND FOLLOW-ON FORMULAE) (AMENDMENT)
 REGULATIONS 2009.**

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Regulations give effect to Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1243/2008 of 12 December, 2008, amending Annexes III and VI to Commission Directive 2006/141/EC as regards compositional requirements for certain infant formulae, and give further effect to Commission Directive 2006/141/EC of 22 December, 2006, on infant formulae and follow-on formulae and amending Directive 1999/21/EC.

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Infant Formulae and Follow-On Formulae) Regulations 2004 (S.I. No. 242 of 2004) in the manner specified in these Regulations.

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Infant Formulae and Follow-On Formulae) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 852 of 2007) in the manner specified in these Regulations.

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Infant Formulae and Follow-On Formulae) (Amendment) Regulations 2009.
