**ELECTRICITY REGULATION ACT 1999 (GAS WORKS)  
 REGULATIONS 2009.**

The Commission for Energy Regulation, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 9G of the Electricity Regulation Act 1999 (No. 23 of 1999), as amended by the Energy (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006 (No. 40 of 2006), having taken into account the matters raised in the public consultation process carried out by the Commission under Section 9G(1) of that Act and with the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources having given his consent has made the above order, S.I. No. 225 of 2009.

These Regulations designate a class of works to be gas works for the purposes of Section 9G(3) of the Electricity Regulation Act 1999. For the purposes of section 9G(3) of the Electricity Regulation Act 1999, 'works which are gas works' means the installation, removal, repair, servicing, maintenance or replacement of a Natural Gas Fitting covered by I.S. 813 which is used or designed to be used by a Domestic Gas Customer, or which is designed to be used by a Domestic Gas Customer but which is installed in a Commercial or an Industrial Premises.
