**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (RESTRICTIVE MEASURES AGAINST CERTAIN PERSONS AND ENTITIES ASSOCIATED WITH USAMA BIN LADEN, THE AL-QAIDA NETWORK AND THE TALIBAN) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2009.**

The Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, Mary Coughlan, T.D., in exercise of the powers conferred on her by Section 3 (as amended by Section 2 of the European Communities Act 2007 (No. 18 of 2007)) of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), has made an order that may be cited as the European Communities (Restrictive Measures against certain persons and entities associated with Usama bin Laden, The Al-Qaida Network and the Taliban) (Amendment) Regulations 2009.

The effect of this Order is to amend the Statutory Instrument that provided for penalties for infringements of Council Regulation (EC) No. 881 of 2002 which introduced measures against certain persons and entities associated with Usama bin Laden, the Al-Qaida Network and the Taliban. The effect of this order is to commence from 5 May, 2009.
