CONSERVATION OF EEL FISHING (PROHIBITION ON
ISSUE OF LICENCES) BYE-LAW NO. 858, 2009.

I, Eamon Ryan, Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act of 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 (as amended by section 6(2) of the Fisheries Act 1980 (No. 1 of 1980)) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and for the purpose of giving full effect to the State's Eel Management Plan under Council Regulation (EC) No. 1100/2007 of the 18 September 2007¹ hereby make the following bye-law:

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the Conservation of Eel Fishing (Prohibition on Issue of Licences) Bye-law No. 858, 2009.

2. This Bye-law comes into operation on the day after the day of its making.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any bye-law, a regional board shall not issue any licences for fishing for eels of the species *Anguilla anguilla* by any fishing method in any fishery district.

4. The Conservation of Eel Fishing (Restriction on Issue of Licences) Bye-Law No. 838, 2008 is revoked.

CONSERVATION OF EEL FISHING BYE-LAW
NO. C.S. 303, 2009.

I, Eamon Ryan, Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act of 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 (as amended by section 6(2) of the Fisheries Act 1980 (No. 1 of 1980)) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and for the purpose of giving full effect to the State's Eel Management Plan under Council Regulation (EC) No. 1100/2007 of the 18 September 2007¹, hereby make the following bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Conservation of Eel Fishing Bye-law No. C.S. 303, 2009.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on the day after the day of its making and ceases to have effect on 30 June 2012.

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any bye-law fixing the annual close season, it is prohibited for a person—

(a) to take, or attempt to take, or to fish for or to attempt to fish for, or to aid or assist in the taking or fishing for, eel, or

(b) to be in possession of or sell or offer for sale eel caught by any means,

in any fishery district.

(2) In this Article “eel” means eel of the species *Anguilla anguilla*.

3. The Conservation of Eel Fishing (Annual Close Season) Bye-Law No. C.S. 297, 2008 is revoked.
