EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (DIETARY FOODS FOR SPECIAL MEDICAL PURPOSES) REGULATIONS 2009.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Regulations give further effect to Commission Directive 1999/21/EC of 25 March, 1999, on dietary foods for special medical purposes, as amended by Corrigendum of 5 January, 2000, and as amended by Commission Directive 2006/82/EC of 23 October, 2006.

These Regulations also give effect for the first time to certain provisions relating to dietary foods for special medical purposes of Commission Directive 2006/141/EC of 22 December, 2006.

These Regulations revoke the European Communities (Dietary Foods for Special Medical Purposes) Regulations 2001 (S.I. No. 64 of 2001), the European Communities (Dietary Foods for Special Medical Purposes) (Amendment) Regulations 2002 (S.I. No. 150 of 2002) and the European Communities (Dietary Foods for Special Medical Purposes) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 241 of 2007).

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Dietary Foods for Special Medical Purposes) Regulations 2009.

CONTROL OF CERTAIN WILD BIRD SPECIES

The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government in exercising the powers conferred on him by Section 3 of the European Communities (Wildlife Act 1976) (Amendment) Regulations 1986 (S.I. No. 254 of 1986) has made Declarations allowing for the control of certain wild bird species during the period from the 1st day of May, 2009, until the 31st day of August, 2009.

The effects of the Declarations are to allow the control of certain wild bird species by landowners or their agents where these species are causing damage to crops, livestock, fauna or where they represent a threat to public health, in the provinces of Connaught, Leinster or Munster or in the counties of Cavan, Donegal or Monaghan. A separate Declaration has been made to allow the control of certain wild bird species by airport authorities or their agents throughout the State where these species represent a threat to air safety.

NOTICE TO MANUFACTURERS, IMPORTERS,
DISTRIBUTORS AND RETAILERS OF CIGARETTE
LIGHTERSCONCERNING EUROPEAN COMMISSION DECISION
RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION ON THE PLACING
OF CERTAIN CIGARETTE LIGHTERS ON THE
MARKET

The European Commission Decision 2009/298/EC of 26 March, 2009, prolongs the validity of Decision 2006/502/EC, concerning the prohibition and sale of certain lighters, until 11 May, 2010. Decision 2009/298/EC was published in the Official Journal of the European Union on 27 March, 2009 — L 81/23.

Decision 2006/502/EC, amended by Decision 2009/298/EC, requires Member States to take measures to:

- ensure that only lighters which are child-resistant are placed on the market and to,
- prohibit the placing on the market of novelty lighters.

Decision 2006/502/EC and Decision 2009/298/EC were adopted in accordance with the provisions of Article 13 of the General Product Safety Directive 2001/95/EC.

The National Consumer Agency, with the cooperation of the Customs Authorities, has responsibility for implementing the Commission Decision in Ireland. The National Consumer Agency is empowered to issue a direction to any operator found not to be complying with the Commission Decision. Any person who fails to comply with such a direction may be guilty of an offence and liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding €3,000 and/or imprisonment for 3 months.
