**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (FORESHORE)
 REGULATIONS 2009.**

These Regulations transpose Directive 2003/35/EC providing for public participation in respect of the drawing up of certain plans and programmes relating to the environment and amending with regard to public participation and access to justice Council Directive 85/337/EEC as it applies to applications which require an Environmental Impact Statement under the Foreshore Acts.

The Regulations amend the existing consultation arrangements for relevant applications including the duration of consultation and the documentation to be made available during consultation. The Regulations also provide for the publication of certain information following the making of a decision on a relevant application.
