These Regulations specify the functions under the Companies Acts of the Director of Corporate Enforcement, officers of the Director of Corporate Enforcement and inspectors appointed by the High Court or the Director of Corporate Enforcement for the purposes of the restrictions set out in section 5(1)(d).
