THE CREDIT INSTITUTIONS (FINANCIAL SUPPORT) SCHEME 2008.

The Credit Institutions (Financial Support) Scheme 2008 (S.I. No. 41 of 2008) provides for the Minister for Finance to guarantee certain liabilities (the "covered liabilities") of banks participating in the Scheme.

Under Paragraph 10 of the Scheme, the Minister for Finance shall publish the total of such covered liabilities in aggregate, quarterly in *Iris Oifigiúil*. The values for the first four quarters are as follows:

1st Quarter value at September 30: €365,046,247,030.

2nd Quarter average October-December value: €352,664,683,524.

3rd Quarter average January-March value: €317,507,470,647.

4th Quarter average April-June value: €275,294,936,349.

These figures have been verified by the external auditors of the covered institutions. In view of the wide range of liabilities covered, points of legal interpretation in relation to more complex financial instruments can arise which could result in amended figures for covered liabilities although any amendments will not materially alter the total figure.
