CONTROL OF CERTAIN WILD BIRD SPECIES.

The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government in exercising the powers conferred on him by Section 3 of the European Communities (Wildlife Act 1976) (Amendment) Regulations 1986 (S.I. No. 254 of 1986) has made declarations allowing for the control of certain wild bird species during the period from the 1st day of September, 2009, until the 31st day of December, 2009.

The effects of the declarations are to allow the control of certain wild bird species by landowners or their agents where these species are causing damage to crops, livestock, fauna or where they represent a threat to public health, in the provinces of Connaught, Leinster or Munster or in the counties of Cavan, Donegal or Monaghan. A separate declaration has been made to allow the control of certain wild bird species by airport authorities or their agents throughout the State where these species represent a threat to air-safety.

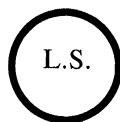

## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS
