## MERCHANT SHIPPING (LIGHT DUES) ORDER 2010.

This Order revokes and replaces the Merchant Shipping (Light Dues) Order 2009. It increases the level of light dues levied on Merchant Shipping collected from vessels calling to ports within the State from 57 cent of 60 cent per ton from 1 April, 2010 and increases the tonnage ceiling from 35,000 net registered tonnage (NRT) to 40,000 (NRT). The maximum number of voyages for which dues may be levied remains at 9 voyages in any one year.
