3.2 Subject to paragraph 4, a person on board an Irish sea-fishing boat less than 55 feet in length, fishing in a fishing area listed in column (2) of Schedule 1, shall not have or retain on board that boat or land (or cause or permit another person to have or retain on board the boat or land), during January 2010, a quantity of a species of fish listed in column (1) of Schedule 1 opposite that fishing area that is greater than the corresponding quantity specified in column (4) if the fish was caught in that fishing area during January 2010.

4.1 A person on board an Irish sea-fishing boat greater than or equal to 55 feet in length in respect of which a deep-sea authorisation has been granted, fishing in a fishing area listed in column (2) of Schedule 2, shall not have or retain on board that boat or land (or cause or permit another person to have or retain on board the boat or land), during January 2010, a quantity of a species of fish listed in column (1) of Schedule 2 opposite that fishing area that is greater than the corresponding quantity specified in column (3) if the fish was caught in that fishing area during January 2010.

4.2 A person on board an Irish sea-fishing boat less than 55 feet in length to which a deep-sea authorisation has been granted, fishing in a fishing area listed in column (2) of Schedule 2, shall not have or retain on board that boat or land (or cause or permit another person to have or retain on board the boat or land), during January 2010, a quantity of a species of fish listed in column (1) of Schedule 2 opposite that fishing area that is greater than the corresponding quantity specified in column (4) if the fish was caught in that fishing area during January 2010.

5.1 Where a quantity is specified in—

- (a) column (3) or column (4) of Schedule 1, or
- (b) column (3) or column (4) of Schedule 2,

in respect of a particular species of fish, fishing area and type of vessel, and where that quantity is expressed as a per cent by-catch, a person on board an Irish sea-fishing boat of that type—

- (c) may, notwithstanding paragraph 3 and 4, have or retain on board, between the hours of 00:01 and 23:59 of each day of a fishing voyage, up to 1.5 times the quantity of that species of fish specified for that fishing area and that type of vessel if it was caught in that area during January 2010, and
- (d) must ensure by 24:00 of each day of a fishing voyage that the quantity of that species of fish caught in that area and retained on board the boat does not exceed the per cent by-catch quantity specified in that Schedule for that species, area and type of vessel.

3. It is prohibited for a person, in a river mentioned in column

- (b) use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks,

“fish” mean either salmon or sea trout or a combination of both;

“salmon” means fish of the species *Salmo salar* (Atlantic salmon);

“sea trout” means fish of the migratory form of *Salmo trutta*, but does not include a sea trout which is 40 centimetres or less in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any bye-law prohibiting the taking or having possession of more than a specified number of salmon or sea trout, a person shall not take by rod and line more than 10 fish in any year.

4. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for a person to take by rod and line—

(a) during the year 2010 from 1 January to 11 May, more than 3 fish, but not more than 1 fish on any day during that period, and

(b) on any day in any year—

(i) from 12 May to 31 August, more than 3 fish, and

(ii) from 1 September to the end of the season, more than 1 fish.

5. It is prohibited for a person, in a river mentioned in column (2) opposite mention of a fishery district in column (1), of the Schedule, where he or she has taken the number of fish permitted under Article 3 or 4 to —

(a) take by rod and line any fish from the waters of the river, other than by catch and release, or

(b) use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, in angling for fish in the waters of the river.

6. The Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. 845, 2008 is revoked.

(a) any fish other than by catch and release, or

(b) use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, in angling for salmon and sea trout in those waters.

4. Subject to Article 3 of the Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout (Bag Limits) Bye-law No. 864, 2009, a person shall not take, from the specified waters, by rod and line on any one day in any year—

(a) from 12 May to 31 August, more than 3 fish, and

(b) from 1 September to the end of the season, more than 1 fish.

5. Subject to Article 6, it is prohibited for a person, in the specified waters, where he or she has taken the number of fish permitted under Article 4, to take by rod and line any further fish from the specified waters other than by catch and release.

6. A person angling for fish in accordance with Article 5 shall not use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks.

7. The Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye-law No. 849, 2008 is revoked.

No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Communications, Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 706 of 2007)) and the Energy and Natural Resources (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2009 (S.I. No. 199 of 2009) and having complied with the requirements of Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997), hereby make the following Bye-law:

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the South Western Fisheries Region (River Bandon) Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout Bye law No. C.S. 305, 2009.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 15 February 2010.

2. In this Bye-law—

“salmon” means fish of the species *Salmo salar* (Atlantic salmon);

“sea trout” means fish of the migratory form of *Salmo trutta*, but does not include a sea trout which is 40 centimetres or less in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any bye-law fixing the annual close season, angling for salmon and sea trout is prohibited in the waters of the River Bandon in the No. 5 or Cork District during the period from 15 February 2010 to 11 May 2010.
