WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY (MARITIME RADIO  
OPERATOR) (CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY)  
REGULATIONS 2010.

The Minister for Transport, Mr. Noel Dempsey, T.D., has made the above entitled Statutory Instrument.

These Regulations provide for the approval of training and examination centres, instructors and examiners for maritime radio operator courses. Provision is also made for the granting, refusal, suspension and revocation of a radio operator Certificate of Competency, the charging of related fees and an offence to operate radio equipment on board a vessel without an appropriate Certificate of Competency.

The Regulations apply to maritime radio personnel and other persons engaged in the operation of maritime radio on board vessels. The vessels to which these Regulations apply are (a) Irish registered ships, and (b) any classes or class of ships or vessels navigating or operating in the State.

EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES ENVIRONMENTAL  
OBJECTIVES (GROUNDWATER) REGULATIONS 2010.

The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, Mr. John Gormley, T.D., has made the above regulations. These Regulations establish a new strengthened regime for the protection of groundwater by giving effect to the measures needed to achieve the environmental objectives established for groundwater by Directive 2000/60/EC and by giving effect to the requirements of Directive 2006/118/EC. The regulations establish clear environmental objectives to be achieved in groundwater bodies within specified timeframes and introduce the legal basis for a more flexible, proportionate and risk-based approach to implementing the legal obligation to prevent or limit inputs of pollutants into groundwater, which already exists under Directive 80/68/EEC.

LABOUR SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ACT 2009  
(COMMENCEMENT) ORDER 2010.

The Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment has signed the above Commencement Order which brings the Labour Services (Amendment) Act 2009 into operation from 20th January, 2010.

The Acts which amends the legislation governing FÁS, provides for a stonger governance and accountability structure at the State’s employment and training agency and, specifically, provides for:

- a reduction in the size of the Board of FÁS from seventeen to eleven (Section 9);
- introduction of a rolling system of appointments to the Board of FÁS (Section 9(5));
- removal of the automatic right to nominate individuals for appointment to the Board of FÁS from bodies not directly accountable to the taxpayer (Section 9);
- making the Director General of FÁS accountable to the Oireachtas (Sections 4 and 5);
- requiring the disclosure of conflicts of interests by directors and staff of FÁS (Section 6);
- banning directors and staff of FÁS from any involvement on matters where they have a conflict of interest (Section 6); and
- protection for “whistleblower” Members of Staff who report serious wrongdoing in the organisation (Section 7).
