**BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS (ATTESTATION OF THE
 STATE AND GENERAL PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT)
 ORDER 2010.**

This new Order amends the Bovine Tuberculosis (Attestation of the State and General Provisions) Order, 1989 (S.I. No. 308 of 1989). The Order enables the Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Food to restrict the movement of animals into or out of a holding where (1) animals not tested within 12 months have been moved to a slaughter premises from a herd that has not been tested within 12 months and (2) animals have not been tested within 18 months have been moved to a slaughter premises from a herd that has been tested within 12 months.
