S.I. No. 197 of 2010.

PROTECTION OF EMPLOYMENT (EXCEPTIONAL COLLECTIVE REDUNDANCIES AND RELATED MATTERS) ACT 2007.

The purpose of this Order is to extend, by a further 3 years until 7 May 2013, the period for which *Part 2* of the Protection of Employment (Exceptional Collective Redundancies and Related Matters) Act 2007 (No. 27 of 2007) shall have effect. This Part of the Act allows for case referrals to the Redundancy Panel in instances where proposed redundancies are considered to constitute exceptional collective redundancies as defined in the Act. This Part of the Act also sets out the process and procedure to be followed in pursuing referrals to the Panel.

MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1977 (CONTROLLED DRUGS) (DECLARATION) ORDER 2010.

The Taoiseach has signed the above Order.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

The purpose of this Order is to declare certain substances, products and preparations to be controlled drugs for the purposes of the Misuse of Drugs Acts 1977 and 1984. The drugs concerned include certain synthetic cannabinoids, benzylpiperazine derivatives, mephedrone and related cathinones, tapentadol, ketamine, amphetaminil, and certain narcotic and psychotropic substances to comply with the United Nations Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs 1961 and the United Nations Convention on Psychotropic Substances 1971.

MISUSE OF DRUGS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS
2010.

The Minister for Health and Children has signed the above Regulations.

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 1988 by inserting certain controlled drugs into the Schedules to the principal Regulations. The Principal Regulations apply controls to the groups of drugs specified in Schedules 1 to 5 of the Regulations (being drugs to which the Misuse of Drugs Acts 1977 and 1984 apply) the effect of which is to impose restrictions on the production, supply, importation and exportation of the drugs in question, which vary according to the extent to which these drugs are used for medical or scientific purposes and having regard to the likelihood of their being abused.

These Regulations insert into Schedule 1 certain synthetic cannabinoids, benzylpiperazine derivatives (with the exception of 2 substances which are inserted into Schedule 3), mephedrone and related cathinones, and other narcotic and psychotropic substances. A number of other substances are inserted into Schedules 2, 3, and 4.

Butan-1, 4-diol and Dihydrofuran-2(3H)-one are not inserted into any schedule. However, article 4 is amended to make it lawful to import, export, produce, supply, or offer to supply these substances except for the purpose of human ingestion other than as a flavouring in food. In addition, a new article 9A is inserted to make it lawful to possess these substances except for the purpose of human ingestion other than as a flavouring in food.

CONTROL OF CERTAIN WILD BIRD SPECIES

The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government in exercising the powers conferred on him by Section 3 of the European Communities (Wildlife Act 1976) (Amendment) Regulations 1986 (S.I. No. 254 of 1986) has made Declarations allowing for the control of certain wild bird species during the period from the 1st day of May 2010 until the 31st day of August 2010.

The effects of the Declarations are to allow the control of certain wild bird species by landowners or their agents where these species are causing damage to crops, livestock, fauna or where they represent a threat to public health, in the provinces of Connaught, Leinster or Munster or in the counties of Cavan, Donegal or Monaghan. A separate Declaration has been made to allow the control of certain wild bird species by airport authorities or their agents throughout the State where these species represent a threat to air-safety.

NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF A CODE OF PRACTICE

The Health and Safety Authority, in accordance with Section 60(1)(a) of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 (No. 10 of 2005), and with the consent of Mr. Dara Calleary, Minister for Labour Affairs and for Public Service Transformation, and following public consultation, has published a Code of Practice entitled "Code of Practice for the Design and Installation of Anchors".

The aim of the Code of Practice is to provide practical guidance to designers, specifiers and installers of metal anchors on the requirements and prohibitions set out in the relevant statutory provisions.

In particular, but not exclusively, this Code of Practice provides practical guidance as to the observance of the provisions of:

- (i) Chapter 1 of Part 2 (Sections 8 to 12 in relation to the general duties of employers) and Chapter 2 of Part 2 (Sections 13 to 15 in relation to the general duties of employees etc.) of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 (No. 10 of 2005);
- (ii) Part 2 (Regulations 6 to 23 in relation to design and management), Part 3 (Regulations 24 to 29 in relation to the general duties of contractors and others) and Part 4 (Regulation 30 in relation to site safety and access to

construction sites, Regulation 35 in relation to protection from falling material and protective safety helmets, Regulation 40 in relation to lighting of work places, Regulation 42 in relation to projecting nails and loose material, Regulation 43 in relation to construction of temporary structures and Regulation 44 in relation to avoidance of danger from collapse of structures) of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 504 of 2006); and

- (iii) Chapter 2 of Part 2 (Regulations 27 to 61 in relation to the use of work equipment), Chapter 3 of Part 2 (Regulations 62 to 67 in relation to personal protective equipment), Part 3 (Regulations 74 to 93 in relation to electricity) and Part 4 (Regulations 94 to 119 in relation to work at height) of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 299 of 2007) as amended by the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 732 of 2007).

The Code of Practice comes into operation on Monday 17th May 2010.
