Pursuant to Section 27 of the Industrial Relations Act 1946, the Labour Court has registered an Employment Agreement between the Irish Business Employers' Confederation and the Irish Contract Cleaning Association who represent employers working within the Contract Cleaning Industry and the Services Industrial Professional and Technical Union (SIPTU), who is a trade union representing employees of firms operating within the Contract Cleaning Industry throughout the State.

This Employment Agreement is effective from Friday, February 3rd, 2012 and sets out the rates of remuneration and conditions of employment of workers employed by Contract Cleaning firms throughout the State who clean the interior of offices, shops, hospitals, factories, stores, apartment buildings and other similar establishments.
